Fire 101-0524 Fire Protection Organization - 3 units (CSU / SC) Mondays 7pm-10pm AA-133
Survey of the fire service and fire protection; career opportunities; history; fire loss analysis; public, quasi-public and private protection; specific fire protection functions; chemistry and physics

Fire 102-0525 Fire Behavior and Combustion – 3 units (CSU / SC) Wednesdays 7pm-10pm AA-145
This course examines the details about the fire. How it starts, continues and is extinguished. In order to handle fire emergencies, you must know the fundamentals of its makeup. This course teaches you on how to suppress the structure, vehicle, rubbish/trash or wildland fire. This course is accredited by the International Fire Service Training Association (IFSTA), National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) and California State Firefighters Association CSFA).
