For homeowners in Priority Hazard Zones*

You cut it, you pile it, we chip it...

- Place your branches on your driveway.
- It is easier and more efficient to chip the piles if they are wider and spread out rather than taller. All the cut ends need to be facing the same direction. No higher than 4 feet. Please follow the photo below for additional instruction on preparing your piles.
- Keep all piles free of rocks, dirt, wire, lumber, **spiny plants**, **poison oak**, and **blackberries**. The chipper can not chip piles of pine needles or leaves.
- You **do not** have to be home the day you are scheduled for chipping.
