PUBLIC MEETING



What: The community is invited to a public meeting hosted by the Contra Costa Fire Protection District to learn information about the future Fire Station #70 that will be at the corner of 23rd Street and Market Avenue in the City of San Pablo. The new station will be built to house two three-person crews for potential expansion of services in the future and will include modern seismic standards as well as being able to meet ADA requirements. The station would be built to provide protection for the community over the next fifty years and would allow for the facility to provide personnel with the components, systems, and features found in a modern fire station.

Who: Fire Department Officials, as well as project team members, including the City of San Pablo, will share more information about the project.

When: 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 10, 2017

Where: San Pablo City Hall, 13831 San Pablo Avenue, San Pablo, CA

Why: The Contra Costa County Fire District operates 25 stations strategically located across the County. Two Stations, #69 & 70 serve the West County. The current station operates from temporary buildings installed after the permanent station was abandoned due to damage sustained in the Loma Prieta Earthquake.
