INCIDENT SUMMARY: Contra Costa Fire crews responded early this morning to a report of a residential structure fire with one person trapped inside the home at 182 Loftus Road. Con Fire Communication Center updated units enroute that the RP was breaking out a window because her husband was still inside the residence. E86 arrived on scene and reported smoke showing from the front of the home and established Loftus IC. Contra Costa Sheriff was on scene and stated a person was trapped in the rear bedroom. Crews were assigned fire attack and search. Hose lines were stretched inside and extinguished the kitchen fire. The front door was removed and a victim was found just inside the doorway. Crews removed the victim and began CPR. Medic 15 and 2 crew members from Engine 85 performed advanced life support skills on scene and during transport to a local hospital. Additional searches were completed and unfortunately two pet birds had succumb to smoke inhalation. Salvage, overhaul, and ventilation were all performed by crews at the scene. PG&E secured gas and electric. The scene was turned over to Emergency Construction to secure the home.

INJURIES: No injuries to any firefighters were reported. One fire victim was transported to the hospital in life threatening condition.

CAUSE: A fire cause and origin was conducted by our Fire Investigator and the fire appeared to have started in the kitchen area.
