INCIDENT SUMMARY: Engine 69 arrived on scene to report heavy smoke and flames showing from the front of a single family, single story residential structure. Battalion Chief 7 arrived with E69 and immediately took command of the incident. E69 began an offensive fire attack as other crews quickly arrived on scene. E70 was assigned primary search and fire attack. During the search, a male occupant was located unresponsive in the burning structure. He was immediately extracted and handed off to waiting fire crews and a medic unit. Advanced life support was provided on the scene for an extended period of time. Ultimately, resuscitation efforts were not successful and the victim was pronounced deceased. The on scene fire crews quickly got the fire under control and extinguished. There was an excessive amount of overhaul preformed before crews were released. At the conclusion of the incident there were no additional injuries reported. The estimated loss is in excess of \$200,000.
