Location: 2700 E. Leland, Pittsburg

Response: E85, T83, R82, BC8, M52, M54, M50, EMS8

Assisting Agencies: Pittsburg PD, ConEMS

Total Fire Personnel at Scene: 10

Contra Costa Fire units responded to an accident with rescue reported on E. Leland in front of Los Medanos College. Pittsburg PD arrived on scene first and diverted traffic around the accident providing for the safety of the victims and rescuers. Engine 85 (Pittsburg) arrived on scene, established command, and ordered additional resources due to the patient count. Engine 85 determined that they had three patients with one possible ejection from a full size sedan. The vehicle had significant damage and intrusion on the driver's side. Truck 83 (Antioch) arrived and performed disentanglement on the vehicle to extricate the driver. The Con EMS Supervisor handled all patient destination decisions and ambulance communication.

Three victims were transported to local hospitals. Fire paramedics assisted with patient care during transport in two of the three ambulances. Contra Costa County Fire and Con EMS worked seamlessly together to provide excellent patient care to multiple patients in a dynamic and stressful environment.
