INCIDENT SUMMARY: Early this morning Contra Costa Fire personnel responded to a reported residential structure fire. Upon arrival, crews discovered a fully involved garage fire spreading to the house and attic area. The first in Captain declared a working fire to the communication center and began assigning resources. Occupants of the home advised on scene fire crews that all family members were accounted for and safe. An aggressive fire attack ensued. Metal sheeting over the exterior roof made this fire a challenge to control. All crews worked extremely hard to extinguish the fire, peel the metal sheeting off the roof and preserve the remaining contents of the structure. There were no reported injuries.
