INCIDENT SUMMARY:

Contra Costa and Moraga-Orinda Firefighters responded to residential structure fire in garage at 3368 South Lucille Lane in Lafayette. Multiple reports of explosions and fire prompted the Dispatch Center to add additional units to the response. Engine 17 arrived first at scene and began fire attack of the well involved attached garage fire. Engine 17 confirmed with the residents on scene that all occupants had safely exited the home. Units from Contra Costa County Fire and Moraga-Orinda Fire brought the fire under control in less than 15 minutes. The garage was destroyed along with all of it's contents were lost. The quick response and amount of Firefighters and resources available enabled crews to keep the fire from extending to the home. Crews remained on scene for several hours to overhaul and confirm the fire was extinguished. Con Fire's On-duty Investigator responded to search for a cause and origin. A board up contractor was requested to secure the garage. The property loss is estimated at \$600.000.
