INCIDENT SUMMARY: Battalion Chief 2 arrived on scene to report heavy smoke and flames showing from the garage and rear portion of a single story, single family home. Immediately upon arrival, several loud explosions were noted by the Incident Commander. It was unclear what was exploding, but determined it was coming from the garage. Heavy winds from the rear of the structure quickly pushed the fire into the main living space of the home. Engine 6 arrived on scene next after implementing a 600 foot hose lay from the hydrant. Engine 6 and Engine 8 immediately began an offensive fire attack which quickly knocked down the main body of the fire. Truck 6 cut several ventilation holes in the roof to make the interior more tenable. Shortly after fire ground operations began, it was reported that the female occupant of the home was reporting that she received burns to her hands and feet while trying to exit the home. She was immediately treated by our safety officer and then transported to the hospital by the medic unit. The remainder of the first alarm arrived and immediately went to work on various missions which quickly brought the fire under control. Due to a quick response and aggressive offensive fire attack, crews were able to quickly extinguish the fire and hold it from spreading to neighboring homes. At the conclusion of the incident there were no reported injuries to fire crews or any other civilians. The estimated loss is in excess of \$400,000.
