INCIDENT SUMMARY: Contra Costa County Fire- Engine 69 (El Sobrante) and Engine and Squad 70 (San Pablo), Battalion 7 (El Sobrante) and Battalion 64 (Richmond) and Investigator 20 (Pittsburg) responded to a Residential Structure fire.

E69 reported light smoke coming from the exterior of a single family dwelling and requested all units continue their response. The incident was not reported as a working fire as it was small and extinguished quickly from the exterior and minimal interior firefighting.

The fire was quickly knocked down and the crews from Station 70 and 69 remained on scene for overhaul and salvage.

The owners were from Alaska and a cousin came to the scene as the responsible party. The origin of the fire was the wall and an exterior wall area. It was an accidental electrical fire that began while nobody occupied the home.

A fire cause investigation was completed.

No injuries occurred to firefighters or civilians. The incident was terminated and the home was turned over to the responsible party. The homeowner was notified.
