Incident Summary:
At 5:34 PM units from the above listed agencies responded to a Plane into the delta that originated from a caller located at the Riverview Lodge who said he saw a plane go down into the water and that it was 2 miles from him and sure it was a full sized plane. At 1745 Battalion 8 arrived on scene at the Antioch Marina and established Marina IC. RB 81 was directed to Sherman Lake Area and FB 85 to the reported location. FB85 found wreckage and a backpack in the water and reported a confirmed plane into the water. At that time a search for victims commenced and Sheriffs Marine Patrol, US Coast Guard, Pittsburg PD and CHP actively engaged in rescue operations. Solano County Dive Team was also requested. NTSB, Buchanon Field and FAA were notified and advised. CCCFPD and CCCSO went into Unified Command and discussed a strategy for the incident. An exhaustive search took place and ultimately was determined to be a recovery operation by CCCSO. IC was turned over to CCCSO and all resources were released. Unfortunately there was one citizen fatality. No rescue personnel were injured.
