Initial on scene report was 2 acres of grass on Navy property. Access issues initially, but made access through Navy property as the fire grew rapidly due to wind. Structure Protection - (Engine companies) were assigned to homes towards the head of the fire. Cal Fire aircraft slowed the fire down and ground crews contained the fire. The fire was contained to 25 acres and no homes or structures damaged. The cause of the fire was a cigarette discarded on Willow Pass Rd in the grass.
