Incident Summary:

T83 arrived first on scene to find a fully involved garage fire with heavy smoke coming from the eaves of a single story home. T83 established Mission IC. E81 arrived immediately after that and command of the fire was transferred so T83 could begin accessing the roof for ventilation. The fire was then reported to the communications center as a working fire in the garage. The garage fire was mitigated by crews and extensive salvage and overhaul was performed by all crews on scene. During the fire an American flag, that was used during the ceremonial burial of the father of one of the residents. As it turns out the flag was used at the funeral of a firefighter. It was returned in tact to the resident. Our firefighters performed in difficult conditions and were able to keep the fire to the garage and the kitchen. The bedrooms were kept safe. Red Cross was contacted and assisted with re-locating 4 adults temporarily. No firefighter or civilian injuries were reported.
