Incident Summary:

Contra Costa County Fire units responded to 25 Belmont Court in the City of Pleasant Hill for the report of Smoke from a residence. Smoke was visible while enroute. Upon arrival B/C 1 reported on conditions "Working House fire - 50% involved" established command and directed first arriving units for water supply.

E5 arrived first on scene and maneuvered into position for fire attack. E5 and E2 drove up the steep court to access the long narrow driveway critical in the confinement and extinguishment of this well involved house fire. E1 promptly dropped 700' of Large diameter hose (LDH) up the long elevated roadway to the waiting pumpers to establish a continuous water supply. E1 positioned at the hydrant to relay pump to the waiting E5. E5 advanced hose lines with E2 started exterior fire attack. Heavy smoke and Fire was pushing from numerous windows and doorways of the 2 story home. T1 arrived and assigned ventilation. The majority of the fire was located in the upstairs Kitchen and family room area and extinguished with exterior hand lines, crews transitioned to an interior fire attack with search for any victims. Simultaneously crews conducted property salvage, fire overhaul, and positive pressure ventilation for smoke removal. The incident was stabilized with 20 minutes of arrival with minimal spread of the fire but the structure had major heat and smoke damage. Investigator 20 was on scene early to perform a cause and origin investigation. A board up company was called to secure the residence. The homeowners were on scene and assisted with property conservation.
