Incident Summary:

At 2:31 pm on February 11, 2020 the Contra Costa Regional Fire Communication Center dispatched 4 fire engines, 1 fire truck, and 2 battalion chiefs, to the report of a residential structure fire. Upon the arrival of the first Battalion Chief(Battalion 5) the alarm was upgraded to a working fire. Additional units responded and assisted. Additionally, 1 Breathing Support, 1 EMS Captain, 1 EMS Supervisor, 1 Paramedic Ambulance and 1 Shift Arson Investigator were added to the response. Upon arrival, the first arriving engine reported nothing showing from a 2 story house. E88 and E82 were assigned 2 out and fire attack. The seat of the fire was found to be in the water heater area. It was quickly extinguished while conducting a primary search for fire victims. None were found and it was confirmed by the renters on site, that everyone was accounted for. Salvage and overhaul operations commenced. It was noted over the radio that this house was a grow house for Marijuana. Their were no exposures (exterior structures) threatened. All fire units provided support to the incident including incident command, fire attack, ventilation, search,

salvage, overhaul, rehab, and investigation. No firefighters or citizens were injured as a result of this incident. The on duty fire investigator was requested and a cause and origin investigation was performed by Investigator 20. The fire cause was determined to be unintentional with the origin in the garage area near the water heater. The residents were given information and the property was released to them.
