Incident Summary:
E5 responded to the 911 report by a neighbor at 204 Greenwich of an exterior fire at 202 Greenwich. E5 reported smoke and flames from 3 blocks away and confirmed a working structure fire upon arrival. E5 obtained its own water supply and quickly worked to protect exposures on the left side of the home. Firefighting was slowed by venting propane tanks and construction materials. Incident command was established and incoming units directed to exterior fire control. Fifty percent of the home was involved in fire. The home was under renovation and Pleasant Hill PD confirmed with home owners at a remote location they were all out of the house. E2 and E9 supported E5 with extinguishing the fire and T6 split it's four-person crew into two teams to cut a vertical ventilation hole and forced entry into a garage door. E13 supported operations with a search of the home after fire knock down. All units remained on scene for extended overhaul of the property.
