Incident Summary:

Contra Costa Fire responded to a report of a Residential Structure Fire with a reported occupant trapped at 5468 Southwood Way in the City of Antioch. An updated report stated that all occupants were out of the house. E82 arrived on scene and reported heavy smoke and fire on the delta side of a two story house. E82 established IC and pulled hose lines to protect the neighboring home. The fire was well advanced throughout the entire home on the first and second floor. Battalion 8 arrived on scene and confirmed that all occupants were out of the house. Crews coordinated an aggressive fire attack by placing several hose lines around the house and knocking the fire down. The occupants had escaped the fire safely. However, six of the nine occupants were treated for smoke inhalation and transported to local hospitals by four Medic Ambulances. Crews remained on scene for over 4 hours due to heavy overhaul operations. The entire house is a total loss. There were no injuries to firefighters. Unfortunately 9 cats, and several reptiles succumbed to the fire. The fire was determined to have started on the first floor area possibly due to electrical issues. This was determined by Investigator 20. PG&E secured both gas and electric. Red cross provided aid to the displaced occupants. Antioch PD assisted with evacuations and traffic control. Emergency Construction Services provided the board up to secure the property.
