Two Alarm Residential Structure Fire

Contra Costa County Fire responded to a two alarm residential structure fire early this afternoon at 1 Sunnyhill Way in Pittsburg. Engine 87 (Pittsburg) reported a large column of smoke while responding to the incident. Con Fire dispatch updated all units responding that there was a person possibly still inside the residence. Battalion 8 requested a second alarm based on this information. Upon arrival Engine 87 reported heavy black smoke from the rear of the house that had spread inside the house and attic space.

A third alarm was requested because the fire had spread into the neighboring backyard and caught a motorhome, large pine trees, and the rear fences on fire. Firefighters extinguished the motorhome, trees and fences to keep the fire from spreading to the neighboring homes. Crews quickly placed hose lines on the burning structure while simultaneously cutting holes in the roof for ventilation. This fire was extinguished because of a well coordinated attack by all firefighters on scene. Searches for civilians were all clear. 7 adults and 5 children were displaced and being taken care of by Red Cross. No injuries were reported. The fire is still under investigation by our Fire Investigation Unit.

No injuries occurred to civilians or firefighters.
