We have reviewed the proposed **kiosk** application and kiosk shop drawings. Our review is to ensure compliance with the minimum code requirements related to fire and life safety as set forth in Section 402.6.2 of the 2022 California Building Code and the 2022 California Fire Code. The following requirements shall be applied to this application:

- Kiosks shall be noncombustible construction or shall be constructed of any of the following materials: fire-retardant-treated wood complying with Section 2303.2 of the CBC, foam plastics having a maximum heat-release rate not greater than 100 kilowatts, and aluminum composite material having a flame spread index of not more than 25 and a smoke-developed index of not more than 450.
- The horizontal distance between kiosks or groupings thereof and other structures shall be a minimum of 20 feet. (Maintain a minimum of 10 feet clear width to a height of 8 feet on each side of the mall between projection from a tenant space bordering the mall and the nearest kiosk or other obstructions to egress.)
- Each kiosk or similar structure or groupings thereof shall have a maximum area of 300 square feet.
- Additional comments:

Our review is not to be construed as encompassing the structural integrity of the facility nor abrogating more restrictive requirements by other agencies having responsibility.
