- 4. Fuel tanks and fill openings shall be closed and sealed to prevent tampering. (CFC 314.4 (3)
- 5. The location of vehicles shall not obstruct means of egress. (California Code of Regulations, Title 19, Division 1, 3.11 (a)

INSIDE TENTS

- 1. Fuel systems shall be inspected for leaks prior to parking vehicle within the facility. (CFC 3107.15.2.2)
- 2. Batteries shall be disconnected in an appropriate manner. (CFC 3107.15.1)
- 3. Vehicles or equipment shall not be fueled or defueled within tent or membrane structures. (3107.15.2)
- 4. Fuel in the fuel tank shall not exceed one-quarter of the tank or 5 gallons, whichever is less. (CFC 3107.15.2.1)
- 5. Fuel tank openings shall be locked and sealed to prevent the escape of vapors. (CFC 3107.15.2.3)
- 6. The location of vehicles shall not obstruct means of egress. (CFC 3107.15.3)
- 7. Fuel for vehicles shall be stored in approved containers in an approved location not less than 50 feet outside the structure. (CFC 3107.15.5.1 and 3107.14.2)
- 8. Refueling of the vehicle shall be performed outside the structure and not less than 20 feet from the tent or membrane structure. (CFC 3107.15.5.2 and 3107.14.3)
