Contra Costa County Fire responded to a reported Residential Structure Fire at 292 Calais Dr. in the City of Pinole.

Engine 73 (Pinole) reported a large column of smoke showing from the station and upon arrival found the front side a single story home heavily involved in fire. Engine 73 assumed incident command and initiated fire attack. All occupants were reported out of the home.

Firefighters initiated an offensive strategy of interior fire attack, search, and vertical ventilation operations to quickly bring the fire under control. The home sustained significant fire damage but the fire was confined to the involved areas home and adjacent homes were un-damaged. Firefighters conducted extensive salvage and overhaul operations.

One Firefighter sustained an injury and was transported to the hospital by our Safety Officer for evaluation and treatment. There were no Civilian Injuries. Displaced Residents will be staying with relatives and declined Red Cross support.

Crockett-Carquinez and Contra Costa County Engine Companies (Martinez and San Pablo) provided coverage in Pinole, Rodeo, and El Sobrante during this incident.
