RESPONSE: 2nd alarm Residential Structure Response

ASSISTING AGENCIES: PD, PG&E

TOTAL FIRE PERSONNEL AT SCENE: 40

At approximately 2145 hours, Contra Costa County Fire Protection District (Con Fire) and Richmond Fire Department units were dispatched to a reported residential structure fire in Rodeo. The reporting party, identified as the homeowner, stated that the carport was on fire.

Engine 75 arrived on scene and reported heavy fire involvement in the carport area, with immediate exposure concerns to an adjacent residence located to the left of the primary structure. Captain 75 established command, declared a working fire, and requested a second-alarm assignment due to the active exposure threat and fire intensity. Initial actions were focused on protecting the exposed structure while advancing handlines to confine the fire to the area of origin.

Additional resources arrived on scene, and multiple hose lines were deployed to control the fire. Firefighters encountered challenging operating conditions due to significant debris and multiple vehicles located around the structure, including one positioned on a vehicle lift, which created potential hazards.

After approximately 20 minutes of coordinated suppression efforts, the fire was brought under control. All occupants had self-evacuated prior to fire department arrival, and no civilian or firefighter injuries were reported.

Preliminary investigation indicates that the fire originated from a contained warming fire maintained by the occupant, which subsequently extended out of control and ignited nearby combustibles.
